





The NABDR® Charitable Foundation Scholarship Fund supports deserving local students pursuing a college or trade education. This program reflects NABDR®'s commitment to investing in the future of our community.

### 2. What is a Dream Maker?

A Dream Maker is an individual who donates to the NABOR® Charitable Foundation Scholarship Fund. Donor participation is limited to REALTORS® (individual licensed real estate agents) and Business Partners (Allied and Affaitiate members) who meet the elisiphitiv requirements.

### 4. What are my scholarship donation options?

- You may choose from one of the following giving categories:
- DREAM MAKER (\$4,000) One 4-Year Scholarship (supports a student pursuing a 4-year college degree)
- VISIONARY (\$4,000) Two 2-Year Scholarships (supports 2 students attending a trade school or community college)
  PATHFINDER (\$2,000) One 2-Year Scholarship (supports 1 student attending a trade school or a community college)

### 5. Can I personalize the name of the scholarship?

Yes. Your naming options are:

- 1. A business name (The ABC Law Firm Scholarship) or
  - 2. A REALTOR®'s name (The Jane Doe, REALTOR® Scholarship)

### 6. Will I be recognized for my donation?

Yes. While the donors and their named scholarships will be recognized by NABOR® at their giving level, the recipient of the scholarship will not be aware of the customized name of your scholarship or your name. The Collier Community Foundation pools all scholarship funds and awards the scholarships through a single application and review process based on a student's merit and need.

#### 7. Where will my donation be held?

All scholarship funds are held and managed by the Collier Community Foundation, ensuring professional oversight, compliance and fair administration of scholarship awards.

#### 8. Am I allowed to select the student who will receive the scholarship I named?

No. You may not select the recipient nor be matched with or have direct access to the student. The scholarships are awarded anonymously by the Collier Community Foundation.

#### 9. How will my donation be allocated?

Donations are pooled into the NABOR® Charitable Foundation Scholarship Fund and awarded according to the recommendations of the Collier Community Foundation's scholarship review committee.

### 10 Could the NABOR® Charitable Foundation Committee revoke my donor application?

Yes. The NABOR® Charitable Foundation Committee reserves the right to revoke or deny a scholarship donor application if, in its sole judgment, the donor's conduct or circumstances would adversely affect the foundation's integrity or reputation.

## 11. Is my donation tax-deductible?

Yes. Since the Collier Community Foundation is a registered nonprofit, your donation is 100% tax-deductible as allowed by law. Please consult your tax advisor for details.

# 12. How do I apply to become a NABOR® Charitable Foundation Scholarship Fund donor?

Complete the NABOR® Charitable Foundation Scholarship Fund donor application online. The form will have a submission button to automatically send the application to the NABOR® Charitable Foundation Committee for review.

#### 13. May I speak about my donation publicly?

Yes! We encourage donors to share their support of the NABOR® Charitable Foundation Scholarship Fund. However, we ask that you please refrain from implying that specific students will receive your named scholarship.

You will empower local students, strengthen our community and gain recognition from NABDR® and the community as a leader within an exclusive group of professionals. If you have ever wanted to create a scholarship in your name, this is your opportunity!
